Quilt Show Insurance for Your Quilt(s)

During the three (3) days that your quilt(s) is hanging in our Annapolis Quilt Show on June 8th (not open to the public), June 9th and 10th, you may want to seriously consider insuring it. The Guild will pay the comprehensive fee for general liability. If you are interested in obtaining insurance for your quilt show entry, please read the following and fill out the form. Please mail it to me by 7th or give it to me at the May meeting (forms and money).

THERE IS NO EXTENSION OF THE DEADLINE DATE OF MAY 7TH.

Insurance will cover quilts, quilt collections, dolls, needlework, similarly quilted items and quilt racks you may have in your possession of the show. It does NOT cover "props" such as antique sewing machines, furniture, etc. the "Quilt" coverage is on a comprehensive basis (excluding wear and tear, deterioration, depreciation, insects, rodents, vermin, rust unexplained disappearance and theft from an unattended motor vehicle unless there are marks of forcible). The charge for this coverage is \$4.50 per \$1000 of value*. Members are required to state the monetary value of their quilt on the registration form below so there is no question as to the quilt's value. If the quilt owner has an appraisal, a copy of it is requested. In lieu of an appraisal, a detailed description, including dimensions, color, pattern, age, etc. and a photograph are accepted. These forms (that is, the appraisal or detail description) must be submitted to the insurance company by our guild – not individually – one month in advance of the show. The insurance company, Day, Deadrick, and Marshall, Inc. is located in Beltsville, Maryland and is the insurer recommended to us through the National Quilting Association, inc. of which we are Chapter #229. Because our guild purchases show liability insurance through this company, personal insurance coverage of your quilt is also available. Individual quilts are NOT covered by guild unless the guild receives your form and premium payment (\$4.50, \$9.00, ... multiples of \$4.50). by May 7th. * For example, if your quilt is valued at \$995 or \$675 or \$325, the cost is \$4.50. However, if your quilt is valued at \$1,200 or \$1,001 the cost would be \$9.00. Submit a separate sheet for each quilt or quilted item. You may photocopy this form. An appraisal may be submitted in place of the descriptive remarks.
