"¼ seam allowance – Press ↑ up. – Press ↓ down - center strip ↓

Samples	No. of strips	Cut Width inches	Bands
#1. 2 fabrics	2	2 x 22 - A 2 x 22 - B	2 Strips – Checkerboard variant  Press to the dark fabric
#2. 2 fabrics	2	2 1/2 x 22 - A 2 1/2 x 22 - B	2 Strips – Sawtooth  Press to the dark fabric
#3. 2 fabrics	3	2½ x 22 - A 1¾ x 22 - B 2½ x 22 - A	3 Strips - Rick Rack. ↓ 
#4 1 fabric 9 fabrics	2 9 □'s	2½ x 22 - A 2 x 2	3 Strips - Squares on Point (flagging) 
#5 3 fabrics	6	2 - 2½ x 22 - A 2 - 1 x 22 - B 1- 1½ x 22 - C WoF same as B	Framed Squares ↓ 
#6 2 fabrics	1 1	1½ x 22 - A 4 ½ x 22 - B	Switcheroo ↓ 
#7 7 fabrics 1 fabric	7 7 2	3½ x 2 (rectangles) 2 x 2 (squares) 2 x 22 (strips)	Squares and Rectangles ↑  Do not sew squares or rectangles together
