

Class Supply List: Annapolis Quilters Guild Workshop

In this class, we will learn how to make one of the Laura Heine Collage. You will learn why we use Steam-A-Seam 2 for applique pieces. Master the cutting and trimming of applique pieces. We will be working on the Teeny Tiny Group #5 (Pincushion, Dress Form & Sewing Machine) pattern and giving ideas for finishing your project.

Kit: Kit available (highly recommended for your first collage). Prices vary depending on which design you pick.

Fabrics: If you select to use your own fabrics, refer to the design on the pattern for required yardage.

**Note from the pattern about fabric if using your own: Good selection of scraps for backgrounds, cuttables, and underlays*

Pattern: Teeny Tiny Group #5. (Pincushion, Dress Form & Sewing Machine)

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

*Kay Buckley medium fine point handle scissors are recommended. (Blue Handle) or NEW Laura Heine Serrated Scissors

*Applique pressing sheet – 17" x 24" I carry Laura Heine Collage mat.

*Steam a Seam 2 (no substitutes) Yardage is stated on your pattern. I will have some with me.

* 19" x 23" Pattern Ease

*Painters Tape or Sew Tites to hold pattern down.

*#2 Pencil for tracing your pattern.

*Stiletto- helpful, but not required

*Rotary cutter, Mat 12" x 18", and 6" x 12" Ruler

*Paper scissors

*Backing: Refer to pattern for actual yardage

*Binding: Refer to pattern for yardage, Stretcher Canvas or Frame

*DRY Iron

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
